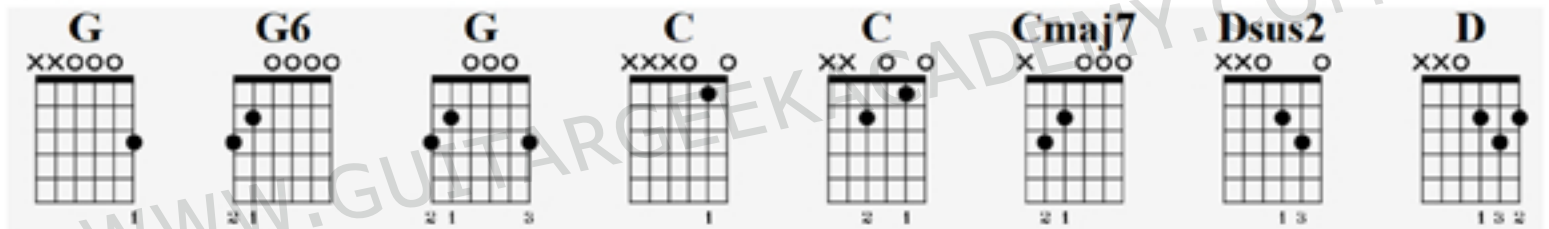


Silent Night (Key of G)

- Time Signature: 3/4
- Strumming Pattern: Count "1, 2, 3" for each chord
- Or, strum once per bar of 3 beats for a simpler style.

In 3/4 time, beat 1 naturally gets an accent, giving the song its signature waltz feel. You can emphasize this by strumming slightly louder on beat 1 while keeping beats 2 and 3 lighter.

This song uses just three simple chords: G, C, and D. To make it accessible for everyone, I've included a chart with the full chord shapes and some easier alternatives. Feel free to pick the chord options that suit your skill level and comfort best!

Additional Verses: Repeat the same number of strums for each verse.
